### **Position Description: Energy Organizer**

The Energy Organizer will work closely with the Federation executive director and as part of a multi-organization team to educate Nebraska organizations, agencies and individuals about energy efficiency, renewable energy, fossil fuels and the energy choices facing Nebraska. Specific duties will include:

- Developing presentations and materials;
- Finding, scheduling and carrying out presentations to community groups and organizations;
- Recruiting and mobilizing volunteers to take action;
- Meeting with business leaders;
- Networking with other organizations and interested people;
- Reporting regularly on activities

Duties may also include:

- Updating web site;
- Organizing events and activities;
- Other duties as agreed to.

This is an independent contractor position with funding through March 31, 2012, for \$1,650 per month. No benefits, but reimbursement for agreed upon expenses will be provided. Specific deliverables will be agreed upon, and we contemplate this will require a substantial, focused effort of at least 20-30 hours per week. There is a possibility that the position could continue in some form depending on availability of funding.
