

POSTER CONTEST RULES AND INFORMATION

Note: Students should access the website NebraskaWildlife.org or participate in classroom activities to gain an understanding of the fish and wildlife that depend on Nebraska rivers, and the need to keep rivers wild.

Follow these directions for Making Posters:

1. Draw or paint a poster, using pencil, crayons, ink, markers, chalk, paint or watercolors. The poster should reflect the 2010 theme: **Keep Rivers Wild for Wildlife.**

2. The words of the theme MUST be printed somewhere on the poster.

3. The poster must be created on 12" x 18" paper.

4. On the back of each student's poster must be printed very legibly:

Student's Name

Student's Address*

Grade Level

Teacher or Sponsor's Name

School or Organization's Name

* **Note:** We use the student addresses to contact winning entrants; if your school or organization does not allow you to give these out, please provide a teacher or organization address so we can contact you directly to help us notify winning entrants.

5. Teacher/sponsors please send in only the posters that best typify the theme.

6. Include *one copy* of the entry form below *with each set of entries.*

10. Posters will be judged by a team on artistic merit and how well they typify the theme.

11. Posters will be judged by grade level (6th, 5th, 4th and below).

13. Winners will be notified by mail in April, and will be honored at the Federation's Annual Gathering **on Saturday, May 1, 2010 at the Pioneers Park Nature Center in Lincoln.**
