Poster Contest Rules and Information

Wildlife Week information is available on our website, www.NebraskaWildlife.org. The theme for Wildlife Week 2018 is Nebraska's Endangered and At Risk Species. It is designed to bring awareness of the many species of animals, birds, and plants in the state which are at risk due to loss of habitat or other factors.

Poster Contest Rules

- 1. The words of the theme must be printed somewhere on the front of the poster.**
 2. Draw or paint a poster using pencil, crayons, ink, markers, chalk, paint, or watercolors. Posters should reflect the 2018 theme: *Nebraska's Endangered and At Risk Species*.
 3. The poster should be created on 11" x 17" poster paper.
 4. On the back of each poster must be printed very legibly:
 - Student name
 - Grade level
 - Teacher or sponsor's name
 - School or organization name
 - Student's address*
- *Note: If your school or organization does not allow you to give out student addresses, please provide a teacher's or organization's address where we can notify the winning entrants.*
5. We encourage teachers to select and send in posters that best typify the theme. Individual entries are also accepted.
 6. Include one copy of the entry form below with each set of posters.
 7. Mail entries to:

 - 8. Entries must be received in the Federation office by Friday, March 30, 2018.**
 9. Posters will be judged by a committee based on artistic merit and how well they typify the theme. Posters will be judged by grade level (6th, 5th, and 4th and below).
 10. Winners will be notified in early April and will be recognized on Saturday, April 28, at Lincoln Earth Day celebration, Union Plaza, Lincoln.
 11. Due to the volume of entries received, we are unable to return entries by mail.
