Poster Contest Rules and Information

Wildlife Week information is available on our website, [www.NebraskaWildlife.org](http://www.NebraskaWildlife.org). The theme for Wildlife Week 2019 is Wildlife in Nebraska State Parks. It is designed to bring awareness of the many species of animals, birds, and plants in the eight state parks in Nebraska, where habitat for wildlife is preserved and maintained.

**Poster Contest Rules**

**1. The words of the theme must be printed somewhere on the front of the poster to avoid disqualification.**

2. Draw or paint a poster using pencil, crayons, ink, markers, chalk, paint, or watercolors. Posters should reflect the 2019 theme: *Wildlife in Nebraska State Parks*.

3. The poster should be created on 11" x 17" poster paper.

4. On the back of each poster must be printed very legibly:

Student name

Grade level

Teacher or sponsor's name

School or organization name

Student's address\*

*\*Note: If your school or organization does not allow you to give out student addresses, please provide a teacher's or organization's address where we can notify the winning entrants.*

5. We encourage teachers to select and send in posters that best typify the theme. Individual entries are also accepted.

6. Include one copy of the entry form below with each set of posters.

**8. Entries must be received in the Federation office by Monday, March 4, 2019.**

9. Posters will be judged by a committee based on artistic merit and how well they typify the theme. Posters will be judged by grade level (6<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, and 4<sup>th</sup> and below).

10. Winners will be notified around March 11 and will be recognized on Saturday, March 30, at Wild Adventure Day at Pioneers Park Nature Center, Lincoln.

11. Due to the volume of entries received, we are unable to return entries by mail.
